II. ADMINISTRATIVE AFFAIRS

Board member, Joyce Meske, moved that the respondent be given until January 27, 2022, to correct the violations of the Edgewood Municipal Code. After January 27, 2022, a monetary penalty of \$250.00 per day shall be imposed for each code violation, until the violation has been corrected, for each code violation. If the compliance time frame expires and the property is still in violation, the Board authorizes the City to abate the violation. Board member, Kenneth Farthing, seconded the motion. The motion carried.
