A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING REVIEW OF THE POLICIES, PROCEDURES AND BEST PRACTICES IN THE SERVICE OF THE CITIZENS OF EDGEWOOD, RESPECTING THE DIVERSITY OF OUR CITIZENRY

WHEREAS, the Edgewood City Council represents a broad and diverse community;
and

WHEREAS, as a Council, we believe we have an obligation to open our eyes, minds
and hearts to the systemic inequities that exists for some groups in our city; and

WHEREAS, all citizens should feel respected, heard and valued in our community; and

WHEREAS, today, we continue to face opportunities and challenges related to
diversity; race and religion, gender and ethnicity, language and sexual orientation, diverse
abilities and disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Edgewood City Council is committed to serve justly, believes in doing
the right thing for the right reason, and recognizes the need to be unbiased and do better
for all our citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD,
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. We condemn the mistreatment and cruelty that has been part of our society
for so many, for so long. We embrace the strength that only diversity can
bring to our community. To make our city more inclusive on every level.
To be more about belonging and open to involvement of all people who live

here. To not just invite, but to reach out with open arms to embrace your participation, your voice, and yes, your anger.

Section 2. Our staff and police officers will continue to participate in ongoing de-escalation, harassment and bias training. The staff, police, and elected representatives will all be participating in additional diversity, equity, and inclusion training.

Section 3. We will work to promote a more diverse and representative composition on our staff, boards, committees, and elected positions.

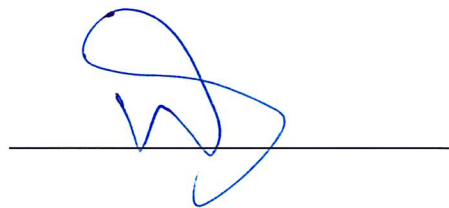
Section 4. We have endorsed a letter of support for Pierce County Council Emergency Resolution R2020-43.

Section 5. We are committed to regular and ongoing discussions, forums, and/or town meetings on this issue, holding at least one per month, starting with a planning session and engaging with local and regional partners.

Section 6. We will provide an update to the community within three months, with the goal of adopting a formal diversity and inclusion plan, identifying ongoing action items, within six months.

Section 7. Effective Date. This resolution will take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council.

After completing contracted advisory meetings with the Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) Subcommittee of the City of Edgewood's City Council, Be Culture recommends the City engage a professional firm with expertise in municipal DEI best practices to conduct a review of the City's policies and procedures, pursuant to City of Edgewood Resolution No. 20-0512.

Background:

Consistent with its contract, Be Culture engaged the EDI Subcommittee in advisory meetings with the following objectives:

- Provide training related to foundational EDI principles for use within the Subcommittee and a potential EDI board/commission.
- Support the Subcommittee as it gauges the needs of the community.
- Build Subcommittee members' skills for operationalizing equitable practices to support increased diversity and inclusion.
- Identify pitfalls to avoid.

Over the course of the engagement, Be Culture identified several considerations leading to the recommendation, including:

- The type of review indicated by the resolution is more appropriately conducted by people with professional expertise in best practices related to EDI as applied in municipal government operations and community access/engagement activities.
- Feedback from community engagement activities conducted by the Subcommittee members indicate it is very unlikely there is sufficient expertise available among City residents to provide the level of technical review indicated by the resolution.
- Feedback from community engagement activities conducted by the Subcommittee members also raise concerns about whether the Council has the training and/or preparation to maximize the kind of feedback that residents are likely to provide.
- After the technical EDI review of policies is complete and, if necessary, best practices are implemented, the development of commission or board made up of community members may be a useful next step. If so, the Council will need to provide clarity about the role of the commission/board and the relationship between the Council and the commission/board.

Be Culture does not perform the type of review being recommended, however Be Culture remains prepared to conduct the final activity in its contract – a Study Session Presentation and Facilitated Discussion with the full Council to:

- Report on Council EDI Committee Advisory meetings, including Foundational EDI principles to be used within the Subcommittee and potential board/commission.
- Facilitate discussions that provide City Council direction regarding the potential board/commissions core purpose / strategic imperative relative to the ongoing growth and success of the City.
- Facilitate discussions that provide City Council direction regarding interrelationship between the board/commission and other boards & commissions, the Council, the Officer of the Mayor, and staff functions.

With this new agreement we are:

- Right sizing our licenses
- Adjusting to new plans that fit our needs better
- Strengthening our online security and access
- Adding some of our server licensing

In addition to purchasing the subscription-based software, the City would like to enter into an agreement with a CDWG Engineer to help with the rollout of the new services. This scope of work would be to assist the IT Director with upgrading our Azure Active directory from the basic version to the Premium version, standing up the new configuration and starting the migration to the enhanced platform. The staff is currently negotiating the SoW but it is anticipated to be around \$10,000.

Below you will see two quotes from CDWG for the first year of payments. The first is from the Omnia State Contract and the 2nd is the current market price for this licensing. As the current market price is roughly \$1,000 a year lower than the state contract, if approved by council, we would like to save some money.

Item History:

In 2020, the City entered into an Agreement with CDWG to purchase Microsoft Licenses for a three-year term. In 2021 and 2022 we added services to this agreement.

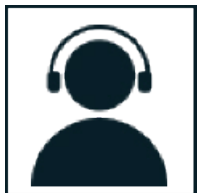

Summary Statement: As the City has experienced rapid growth in recent years, the number of parking-related complaints within the public right-of-way has increased. Council adopted Ordinance 19-0554 on August 13, 2019, enacting parking enforcement regulations similar to those found in other municipalities in the area. Ordinance 20-0587 was adopted on October 27, 2020, clarifying signage requirements and adding to the “No Parking – Tow-Away Zone” list.

As "No Parking" signage already exists, three additional “Tow-Away Zone” locations are being proposed:

- 1) 20th Street East, between Meridian Avenue East (SR-161) and the entrances to the Edgewood Heights and The Arbors multifamily complexes,
- 2) 8th Street East, on the south side between 107th Avenue East and 108th Avenue East, and
- 3) 8th Street East, on the north side abutting the Hedden Elementary School campus.

Staff offers the attached draft ordinance for Council’s consideration, which would update the “No Parking – Tow-Away Zone” list accordingly.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-0XXX

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY; AMENDING SECTION 10.12.020 OF THE EDGEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance 19-0554 on August 13, 2019, establishing Edgewood Municipal Code (EMC) Chapter 10.12, “Parking”; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide appropriate notice to the public and enable enforcement of areas designated as a “NO PARKING – TOW-AWAY ZONE”, the City Council adopted Ordinance 20-0587 on October 27, 2020 to ensure appropriate signage is installed; and

WHEREAS, there are some areas in the City already designated as “NO PARKING” zones that are not currently designated as a “NO PARKING – TOW-AWAY ZONE” in EMC; and

WHEREAS, the Council discussed this Ordinance during its February 7, 2023 study session; and

WHEREAS, the Council considered this Ordinance during its regular City Council meeting of February 14, 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, WASHINGTON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. EMC Subsection 10.12.020(M) Amended. Edgewood Municipal Code Subsection 10.12.020(M) is hereby amended to read as follows:

M. No person shall park a vehicle in any areas designated with official “No Parking” signage or markings. In addition, the following areas shall be designated with appropriate signage and parking in these areas is subject to immediate impoundment:
