B. Comcast Franchise Agreement

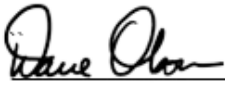
Assistant City Administrator Dave Gray brought this agreement back for further review prior to its second and final reading at the upcoming regular council meeting.

5 OTHER COUNCIL ITEMS

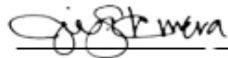
Deputy Mayor Tomin, Councilmember Ramirez, and Mayor Olson spoke.
