F. Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) Updates

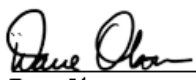
At the Council's request, Community Development Director Metzler gave a brief overview of what the Economic Development Advisory Board had been recently discussing at their meetings.

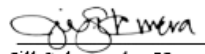
4 OTHER COUNCIL ITEMS
