3 COUNCIL BUSINESS

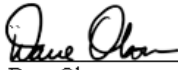
- A. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Council Sub-Committee Update
Councilmember Southard discussed their earlier sub-committee meeting where they reviewed the City of Edgewood Equity Lens Policy, and discussed the possibility of upcoming listening sessions with Walker High School and local apartment complexes.
- B. Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) Updates
Community Development Director Metzler provided an overview of the board's monthly developments and activities, highlighting key initiatives and progress.
- C. Impact Fee Code Amendments
Community Development Director Metzler initiated a discussion on updating Traffic Impact Fees (TIFs), with further deliberations—including recommendations from the Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) regarding non-residential land uses—scheduled for an upcoming study session.
- D. Land Use Table Updates
Director Metzler presented this item, detailing that following several months of deliberations and contributions from the Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB), the Planning Commission unanimously endorsed their recommendation to the City Council during the meeting convened on June 9, 2025.
- E. Budget Discussion
Finance Director Goraya provided the City Council with a comprehensive overview of the current fiscal status, highlighting key budgetary developments and financial projections.
