A. Food Truck Event

Staff discussed potential site improvements related to the Windmill Relocation, including additional gravel and electrical hookups to support food truck and market events. Using part of the lawn for parking was also considered, pending further discussion with Public Works. Additionally, staff noted the need to develop special event regulations, targeting Q4 2025/Q1 2026 for review by the Planning Commission and City Council.

B. 2026 Work Plan Review

Staff noted that no funds are currently budgeted for economic development. The EDAB will continue advising the Mayor and Council per code, with staff coordination as needed, and is encouraged to pursue creative solutions, volunteers, and partnerships to achieve the 2025–2026 Work Plan goals.
