1 CALL TO ORDER

2 COUNCIL BUSINESS

- A. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Council Sub-Committee Update**
Councilmember Buckley summarized feedback from the listening session at the Mountain View Community Center. Residents discussed misconceptions about the City's share of tax revenue, challenges attending evening meetings, the importance of public safety and community programming, the need for better communication beyond online channels, and interest in recruiting more participants for City boards and commissions.
- B. Boards & Commission Alternates**
Councilmember Buckley highlighted the need to better promote the City's boards and commissions and suggested offering alternate member opportunities when there are more applicants than vacancies. The Council then discussed how such an option could be structured.
- C. Budget Discussion**
Mayor Olson and Finance Director Goraya presented an overview of the budget, including initial projections, current figures, and items that have been reduced or deferred. Council discussion ensued.
- D. Robert's Rules of Order Discussion**
City Attorney Maili Barber provided training for those in attendance on Robert's Rules of Order, and then answered the Council's questions.
