1 CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Olson called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and Andrew Wiesenfeld led attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2 COUNCIL BUSINESS

A. 2026 Boards/Commission Work Plans

- a. Planning Commission
- b. Economic Development Advisory Board
- c. Parks & Recreation Advisory Board

Parks and Recreation Advisory Board staff liaison Chuck Hendricksen, Economic Development Advisory Board Chair Kelsey Morgan, and Planning Commission Chair JoAnn Overfield presented their 2026 Work Plans, and answered the Council's questions.

B. Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Council Sub-Committee Update

Councilmember Southard provided a briefing to the Council regarding their subcommittee meeting.

C. 2026 Annual Comprehensive Plan Amendment Docket

Council was briefed on two proposed 2026 Comprehensive Plan Amendments (25-001 and 25-002). The Planning Commission recommended both for inclusion in the Final Docket, which is tentatively scheduled for adoption next week.

D. Climate Element Grant Agreement

Council was advised that, under 2023 ESHB 1181, the City will update its comprehensive plan and development regulations, and will accept \$395,000 in state grant funding to complete the work, which begins immediately.

E. Climate Element Consultant Agreement

Council was briefed on a draft resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a \$395,000 grant agreement with the State and a \$320,000 contract with Measure Meant Consulting to complete the City's Climate Element, including Resiliency and GHG Reduction sub-elements, by June 15, 2027.

F. Fee Schedule Update

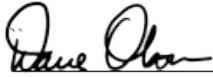
Council reviewed the proposed updates to the City's Fee Schedule, including minor revisions to Franchise, Road Cut, and Tree Replacement fees. A detailed discussion then ensued between the Council and staff.

3 OTHER COUNCIL ITEMS

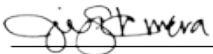
