A. EDAB Procedure Amendments - Action

B. Economic Development Webpage Content

The board reviewed a draft Economic Development webpage, discussing layout, messaging, and target audience. Key topics included clarifying how opportunities (like attracting a grocery store) are presented, improving visuals and mobile formatting, and adding content such as business resources, demographic data, and community highlights. The webpage remains a work in progress, with further revisions planned before going live.

4 STAFF UPDATES/COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

The City provided an update on the food truck pilot program, noting it has launched with multiple vendors scheduled throughout the week and at community park locations. Initial turnout was modest, but the City is promoting the program through social media, signage, and community outreach, with plans to expand participation and potentially reopen applications. Staff also shared that updates to home business regulations will be reviewed by the Planning Commission, and that multifamily tax exemptions are being introduced as a potential tool to support mixed-use development and affordable housing.
