COUNCIL STUDY SESSION SUMMARY**

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Eidinger noted he would like to change the time of Connect over Coffee to 8:30am-10:00am.

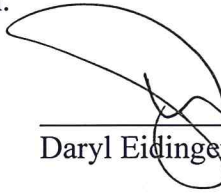
Councilmember Meyers asked if at the September 16 meeting a discussion regarding utility tax and the communications strategies regarding it.
