1. CALL TO ORDER

Salary Commissioner Jason Neil presented Council with the commission's recommendations, and how they came to their decisions. Further discussion followed between Council and staff.

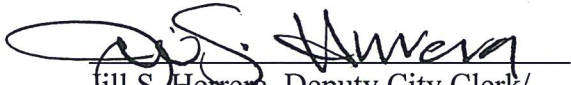
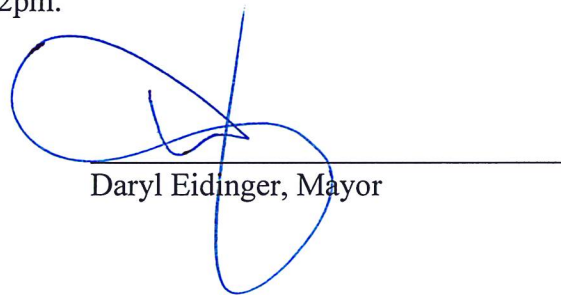
